The Lynchburg Story: Eugenic Sterilization in America

Between 1927 and 1972, over 8,000 people at the Lynchburg Colony for the Epileptic and Feebleminded in Virginia were forcibly sterilized. Most were simply poor, ill-educated, and considered a financial burden on the state. This documentary provides historical context and interviews with victims who tell the devastating impact on their lives.
